

No-Sew Fleece Blankets



Supplies Needed:

- Fleece (2 different colors or patterns)
- Scissors
- Ruler or Tape Measure

Steps:

1. Cut 2 squares of fleece, 48" in length;
2. Lay one square on top of the other – wrong sides together (so the fuzzy sides are on the outside);
3. With the fleece squares stacked on top of one another, cut a 5" square from each corner;



4. With the squares still stacked, make the fringe:
 - a. Cut 5" into the fleece at 1" intervals all sides – *please try to be as neat and consistent as possible*;



- b. Knot the fringed pieces together around all four sides, tying a piece from the top layer to a piece from the bottom layer:

First, wrap the fringe around your finger.



Pull the end up and over the top of the fringe and push it through the loop.



Pull the end through.



Push up on the knot and tighten it, sort of like you would tie a necktie.
